Thanks for being a part of the 1st Annual Midtown Sertoma 5k Run & Walk for Better Hearing taking place at the Arizona School for the Deaf & Blind, 1200 W. Speedway Blvd.. We hope you enjoy it and we thank you for helping us raise much needed funds for our hearing related projects.

Midtown Sertoma All proceeds will benefit the Arizona School for the Deaf and Blind, which has experienced significant State funding reductions, Midtown Sertoma Audiology scholarships and the Adult Loss of Hearing Association - all operating in Tucson.

What is the Midtown Sertoma Club? Midtown Sertoma Club of Tucson is led by our 25 civic minded Tucsonans who joined together to contribute to the needs of our community. Fund-raising projects raise \$10,000 to \$20,000 annually for distribution to our sponsorships and monthly food boxes for hundreds of needy families served by the Community Food Bank. Midtown Sertoma also funds several Audiology scholarships at the University of Arizona. Worldwide, Sertoma is an international civic organization with over 20,000 members. If service to mankind interests you, please speak to our members at our tent on race day.

Directions to the school track: the school is located at 1200 W. Speedway, which is on the right side of Speedway, just west of I-10. Speedway. The start & finish and post race festival takes place on the track and football field, which is at the far east part of the school (first entrance west of I-10).

Parking Details: Parking is plentiful. The east lot, nearest the start line, will fill first. When that lot is full, our parking team will direct you to the far west lot and then to the northwest lot. The further lots are about a 5 minute walk to the track, so please arrive in time to be ready for the 8:30 a.m. event start time.

Timing: This event will be shot-gun timed event and you must wear your bib on the front of your body to receive your time and so you can find your post race photo at www.flickr.com/everyoneruns.

The course: see course map. Our USA Track & Field certified course travels 1.5 laps on the track and then north to your out & back on the Santa Cruz River Trail and then to your finish on the track. It's that simple and we'll have plenty of monitors on the course to make sure you don't get lost! While on the river trail, we ask that you run on the right. Walkers: please do not walk two across, so that others may easily pass you when needed.

Finisher Performance Tech Shirts: your finisher tech shirt will await you at the finish line. Your size is reserved and is noted at the shirt table. We cannot change your size until after the event is over.

Water/Aid stations: there will be one water/XOOD performance drink station prior to the turnaround on the Santa Cruz River Trail and you can access it in either direction. Our water station volunteers will pass water cups to you. When you cross the finish line a bottle of water will await you!

Post-Event & Awards: eat, drink and have fun! Enjoy your free Mexican breakfast and visit our sponsors and clubs from the school and our community. Our awards ceremony will start around 9:30 a.m. (give or take 15 minutes or so).

We have determined awards based on participation as follows:

- Overall male & female: 1st, 2nd and 3rd places
- Age groups from 10-14, 15 - 19, 20 - 24, 5 year groups thereafter up to 70-74 and then 75+.
- Overall winners will be removed from age group qualification
